Horses must not be left unattended unless securely boxed and must not be tethered within the arena

All horses or ponies when outside the arena should be moved **at the walk only** to ensure the safety of spectators & pedestrians.

No persons allowed in the warming up arenas unless on horseback.

Do not skip out onto the showground - use bins provided

No lunging

Please do not ride in the fields

No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
