FORMAT & ARENA/COURSE LAYOUT

The winner is the competitor with the least number of penalties who is closest to the optimum time.

There will be showjumps followed by a variety of portable cross country fences. An optimum time will be set for the full course. The rider should proceed immediately from the showjumps to the cross country jumps. Cross country colours, body protectors, number bibs and medical armbands must be worn.

Number bibs are not available to hire.

Penalties

Knock Down 4 faults

1st refusal 4 faults

2nd refusal 8 faults

3rd refusal Elimination

Fall of horse or rider Elimination

Correct Dress & Tack must be worn whilst in the arena.

No smoking allowed on the yard

Correctly fitting and secured hats in good condition and conforming to current BSI Specifications must be worn on horseback at all times.

The judge and organisers decision is final

Children must be supervised at all times

Horses must not be left unattended unless securely boxed and must not be tethered within the arena

All horses or ponies when outside the arena should be moved **at the walk only** to ensure the safety of spectators & pedestrians.

No persons allowed in the warming up arenas unless on horseback.

Do not skip out onto the showground - use bins provided

No lunging

Please do not ride in the fields

BSJA Rule 82.21

No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
